

● For tree branches, cut into sticks less than 50 cm long, and within 5 cm in diameter; tie with string into bundles (about 15 cm in diameter) before disposal. Up to three bundles can be disposed of per collection. Four bundles or more at one time will be treated as bulky items.

For boards or pieces of wood, cut into pieces less than 50 cm long and 1 cm thick; tie with string into bundles. Up to ten boards can be disposed of per collection. Eleven boards or more at one time would be treated as bulky
